## Dual Credit Course Information

### Overview

In Dual Credit courses, students earn both high school credits (usually 5) and a post-secondary course credit in a particular interest area. These courses are delivered on-line and some have a practicum component. They familiarize students with on-line learning and allow you to complete courses towards possible post-secondary goals. If interested please see your counselor or contact STAR Outreach. It is best to register for these courses early and no later than the end of the first five student days in either September (Term 1) or February (Term 2). The following Dual Credit courses are currently available through STAR Catholic Outreach:

**Play** - Students explore the significance of play in the development of a child. Part of the Early Learning and Child Care Program.

**Health, Safety, and Nutrition** - Part of the Early Learning and Child Care Program. It focuses on health services by exploring nutrition and wellness.

**Environmental Sustainability** - For those interested in environmental sciences. Focuses on human interactions with the environment.

**Introduction to Esthetics** - An overview of safe practices, developing a professional image and the skills required to work with the public.

**Introduction to Heavy Oil and Gas** - Explains what heavy oil is, how it is taken out of the ground and to the marketplace.

**Introduction to Soil Science** - An overview of the soil formation process and soil characteristics

**Health Care Aide** - This first section looks at working safely and effectively as a health care aide and communication in the health care environment. (Pre-req. Eng.10)

**Youth Evangelization** - This is designed for students interested in working in parish youth ministry and who wish to develop skills for effectively engaging people in parish settings.

*For these courses, it is recommended that you either have or are taking a 20 level English.*

**Intro to Management** - Learners are introduced to concepts, terms, and theories that provide an understanding of the principles of organizational management. (Term 1)

**Intro to Psychology** - This course gives students a basic understanding of the diverse field of psychology including the scientific method, dreaming, learning, memory, intelligence, motivation, personality, and social psychology. (Term 1 - Recommended for Gr. 12)

**Medical Terminology I** - This course offers instruction in the language of medical terminology and teaches you how to read and interpret commonly used medical terms, symbols and abbreviations. (Term 1)

**Medical Terminology II** - This course continues the instruction in the language of medical terminology and builds on the previously learned subject matter in HUCL 1401. Medical Terminology II integrates word components into exploring body systems, pathological conditions, lab and diagnostic procedures, and medication/drug classifications. (Term 1 - Prerequisite: HUCL 1401)

**Business Communication** - This course covers the theory and practice of effective communication. The course will emphasize class participation through discussion boards, professional conduct, problem-solving and critical thinking as it relates to the communication process. (Term 2)

**Medical Terminology I** – See above (Term 2)

**Health Education: Personal Health & Wellness** - An overview, within the context of community and the Canadian Health Care System, of the physical, social, mental, environmental, and spiritual aspects of personal health. (Term 2)

**Intro to the Criminal Justice System** - A study of Canada's Criminal Justice System in the sequence as seen by an offender who traverses it including: the role and functions of the police and other agencies, the courts, sentencing philosophies, correctional institutions, community corrections, and diversion. (Term 2)
